1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Nessen at 5:56pm.

The Secretary to the Board took an attendance roll call due to it being a virtual meeting.

2. Review of the FY222 Audited Financials with College Auditors from O'Connor & Drew, LLP

Brian Crowley of O'Connor & Drew reviewed the independent auditor's report, including the final opinions, basis for opinions, and change in accounting principle specifically regarding *GASB* 87 changes. *GASB* 87 reporting required a retroactive depreciation and interest expense entry to account for the leased MSCBA properties that are now assets on our financial statements

The audit was completed by the statutory deadline and there were no findings.

The discussion touched upon different elements of the financial statements and impacting factors such as an increase in out-of-state students relative to in-state students increasing tuition and fees and the impact of ARPA and CARES funding.

There were no capital and/or material deficiencies and there were no smaller findings; all funds are being recorded and accounted for by all required standards and there is no loss or other inadequacies in MassArt's processes.

Discussion also touched upon the significance of the MSCBA buildings being owned by the Commonwealth, not the college.

President Grant met independently with the Auditors.

3. It was then VOTED: To accept the FY22 Massachusetts College of Art and Design Audit, by roll-call vote.

The Audit was accepted by roll call vote conducted by the secretary to board – all in favor.
