PCE/Youth Programs

Anne Marie Stein, Dean of Professional and Continuing Education, presented information relating to matriculation by students who had previously taken youth programs or PCE classes. Draft Diversity Plan

Mo Barbosa (Health Resources in Action), Jamie Costello, Dean of Students, and Dan Serig, Associate VP of Academic Affairs, distributed a draft copy of the Diversity Plan and the group went over each of its three goals and the steps of their action plan to achieve each goal. People received clarification and gave suggestions that will now be written into the next version, along with feedback from other populations on campus such as the Chairs and Student Government. The final plan must go through the Governance Committees, Ken Strickland, Interim President/Provost and finally be approved by the Board of Trustees.

Student Leave of Absence Policy and Crisis, Catastrophic Emergency and Postvention Manual

Jamie Costello, Dean of Students, presented the group with copies of the updated Student Leave of Absence Policy and a copy of the Crisis, Catastrophic Emergency and Postvention Manual. Both documents were updated using the standards of the Jed and Clinton Foundation, which focuses on the emotional wellbeing and mental health of college students.
