The office of Environmental Health and Safety is responsible for ensuring that all laws that apply to the College are properly followed (i.e. hazardous waste disposal, "Right-To-Know", etc.) The Safety Office is located in T-401. This office provides safety training, respirator fit-testing, air quality investigations, ergonomics assessments, and is available for safety advice whenever needed. The recycling program and sustainability efforts are also managed by this office.

Our primary goal is to provide our community with a healthy and safe working environment, by promoting and supporting Safety and Health Programs.
